

Guaranteed Admission Agreement
Between
SUNY Morrisville
Massage Therapy, A.A.S. Degree Program
And
Madison-Oneida BOCES
Cosmetology Career & Technical Education Program

General Student Agreement

SUNY Morrisville recognizes the hard work and determination that is demonstrated by Madison-Oneida BOCES students and graduates in order to achieve their goal of completing career-based training. Consistent with its institutional mission to inspire learning through experience, SUNY Morrisville enters into this guaranteed admission agreement with Madison-Oneida BOCES to provide an opportunity for continued education in a career-based program at the post-secondary level. The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing a Career and Technical Education (CTE) program in Cosmetology at Madison-Oneida BOCES and who plan to continue their education in the Massage Therapy, A.A.S. degree program at SUNY Morrisville.

Specific Articulation Provisions

SUNY Morrisville will guarantee admission as a first-time freshman into the Massage Therapy, A.A.S. degree program to Madison-Oneida BOCES students and graduates who meet the following criteria:

1. Students must earn a cumulative grade point average of 80 or better in the Cosmetology program at Madison-Oneida BOCES.
2. Students must complete a minimum of two (2) science courses throughout their high school curriculum, one of which must be Living Environment (see below for course grade/regents requirements).
3. Students must achieve a Living Environment course grade of 80 or better and a Living Environment regents score of 75 or better.
4. Students must enroll full-time (minimum 12 credits per semester) in the Massage Therapy, A.A.S. degree program at SUNY Morrisville within 12 months of successful completion of the Cosmetology program at Madison-Oneida BOCES.

The following documents must be submitted in order to finalize the student's acceptance into the Massage Therapy, A.A.S. degree program at SUNY Morrisville:

1. A completed SUNY Application or Common Application, including the \$50 application fee or approved fee waiver
2. An official copy of the student's high school transcript
3. An official copy of the student's CTE program record and certificate of completion
4. One letter of recommendation from a Cosmetology instructor at Madison-Oneida BOCES


This agreement is applicable to first-time freshman students only. Students who matriculate at another college or university prior to enrolling at SUNY Morrisville are considered transfer students and are not eligible for guaranteed admission based on the terms of this agreement.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years. This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon by mutual agreement of both parties.






