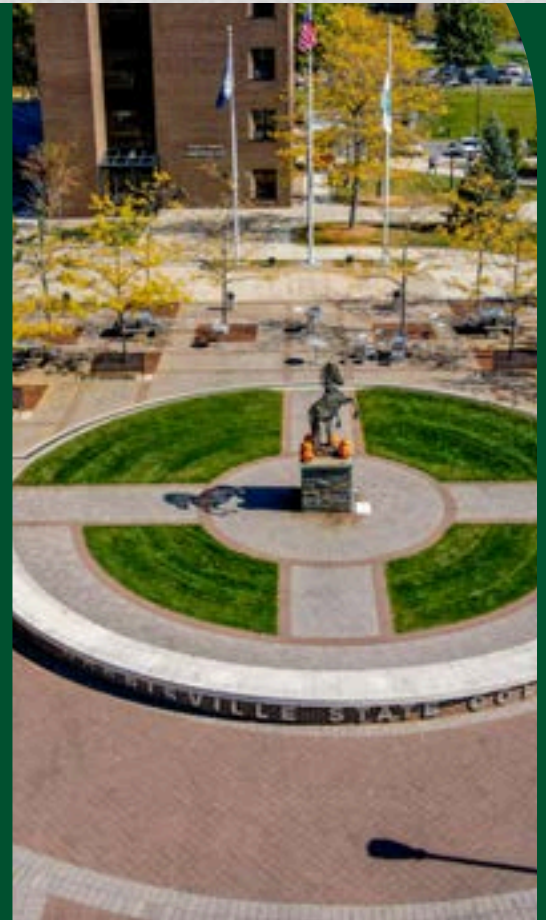

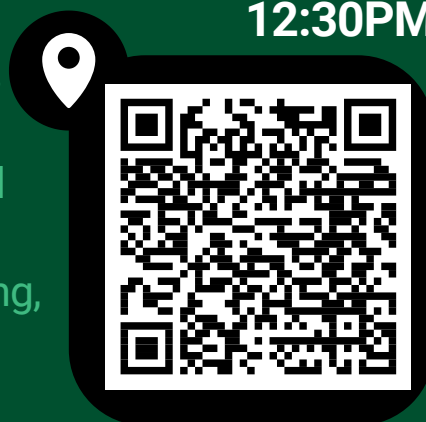
Nature Trail Hike

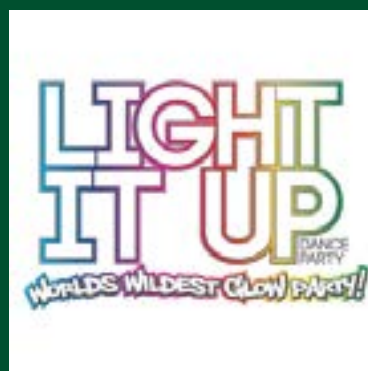

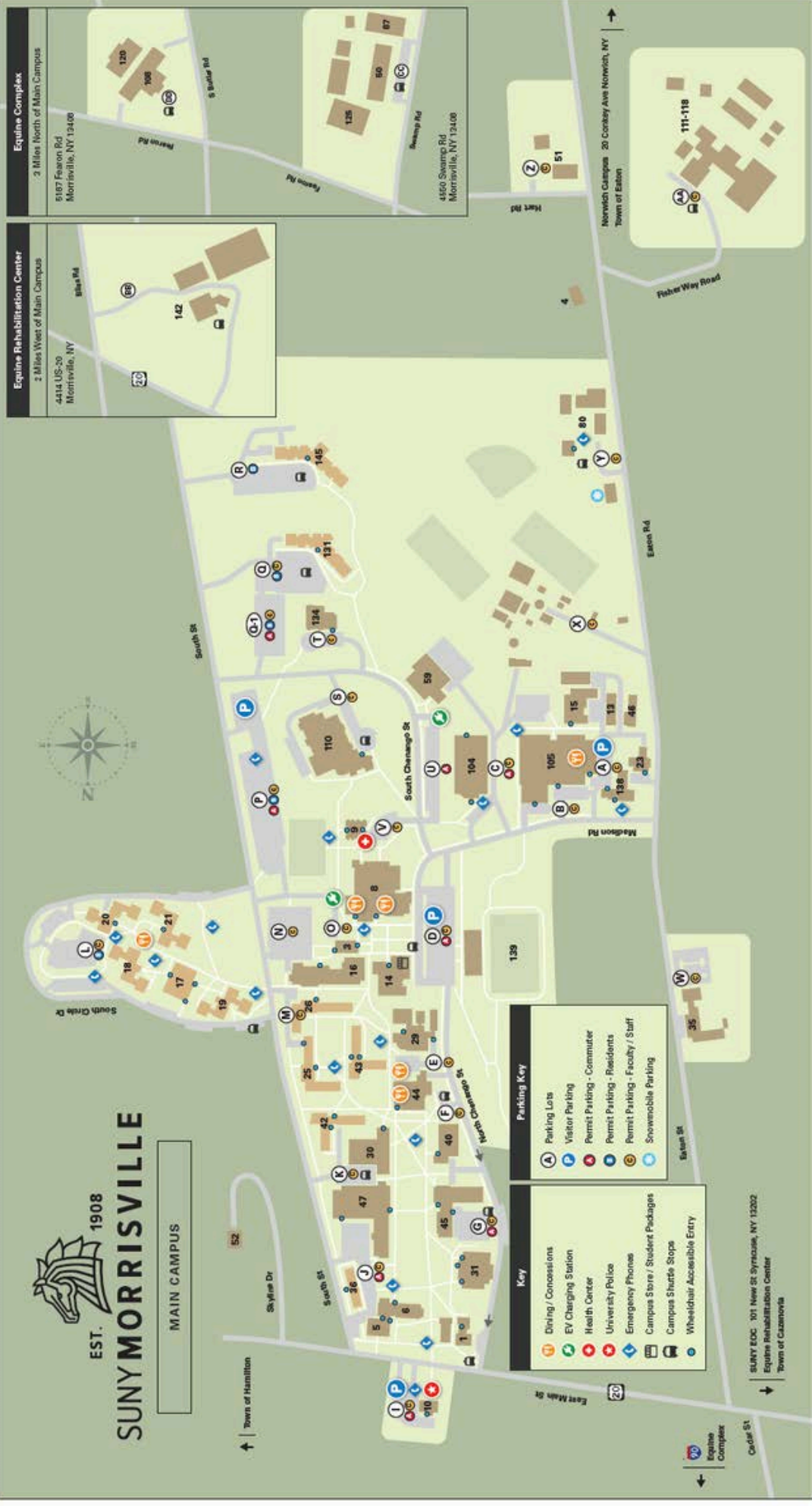
